Prepare for an emergency or disaster.



Keep up to date on pet IDs, licenses, and vaccines.



Keep potentially poisonous plants, chemicals, and medicines away from pets.



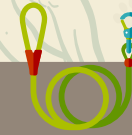
Spay or neuter your pet.



In case of a fire, get out and stay out. Tell firefighters if your pet is trapped.



Be kind to animals; pet gently with no pulling, tugging, or teasing.



Always secure your pet while riding in the car. Riding in an open truck bed can be deadly.



Keep pets away from cooking areas and use flameless candles.



Always ask permission before petting an animal.
